Major Industrial highlights of the week:

- Textile exports continued strong growth, rising 10.43% year-on-year to \$1.65 billion in May 2026, reaching \$18.22 billion during the first 11 months of FY26.
- Construction and fertilizer sectors saw mixed developments: cement dispatches declined by 21% in May, while the fertilizer industry recorded 8% growth in the first five months of 2026, supported by progress on a proposed \$1.12 billion coal-to-urea project.

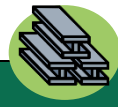
