Major Industrial highlights of the week:

- Textile exports reached USD 16.67 billion during the first 11 months of FY2025-26, demonstrating steady sectoral growth and export resilience.
- The government reaffirmed its commitment to strengthening Pakistan's cotton sector.
- Industry representatives criticized the federal budget for providing limited relief to industrial and agricultural sectors.
- Pakistan continues to rely heavily on imported cotton, with annual imports from the United States reaching approximately USD 800 million.

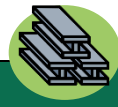
