

WEEKLY INDUSTRIAL WATCH

Jun 29th, 2026 – Jul 05th, 2026

Major Industrial highlights of the week:

There were very few noteworthy industrial developments during **29 June–5 July 2026**. Much of the reporting focused on routine market updates and performance indicators rather than transformational events, making it a comparatively quiet week for Pakistan's industrial landscape.

- SAARC CCI strengthened industrial and trade engagement with China, highlighting continued efforts to expand regional business cooperation and investment opportunities.
- Pakistan's cement sector showed signs of recovery, although analysts noted that growth remains below the pace required for sustained industry expansion.
- Cement dispatches increased by 7.2%, reaching 50.5 million tonnes in FY26, indicating improving domestic demand and export performance compared to the previous year.

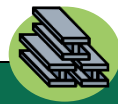
