

Major Industrial highlights of the week:

- Pakistan is launching the second phase of its Tariff Reform Plan in the upcoming FY27 budget, slashing additional customs and regulatory duties to provide Rs200 billion in import relief to the industrial sector, targeting highly protected areas like automobiles, steel, and textiles to lower market prices and boost global competitiveness.
- There has been no significant news or major developments this week due to the Eid holidays.
